 - b. That Captain Phillips operated within normal parameters for the ship characteristics and conditions.
- 3. **Proposed Recommendations** Following its deliberations, by a vote of 8-0, the PBIRC proposes the following recommendations to the Board of Pilot Commissioners for Harris County Ports:
 - a. Take no action and close to file.
